Dear Parents /Carers,

Horniman Museum – 21st November 2023

Our topic in Year 2 this half term is The Arctic! As part of our learning, we will be going on a trip to the Horniman Museum on **Tuesday 21st November**, to explore their Arctic exhibit and investigate about our topic.

We will be travelling on the 9.40am train from **Petts Wood station** to Penge East, and will then catch the 176 bus from the high street to the museum. We will stagger the buses, with Snowdrop getting on the first bus and Traveller's Joy getting on the second. We will arrive at the museum at approximately 10.30am.

As this is so close to the start of the school day, we ask to meet you at the station rather than bringing your children to school. The meeting point will be by the little row of shops on the Morrison's side of the station. Please be there for **9.15am**, so that we have time to register the children and don't miss the train. If this is not possible, please speak to the class teacher. If your child is due to attend Galaxy that morning, we will walk them up to the station ourselves, leaving the school around 8.45am.

On the return trip, we will stagger the buses again, and all meet at Penge East to catch the train back to Petts Wood station. You can collect your child at **3.05pm** from the station. We will then walk back to school with the Galaxy children. Again, please let your child's class teacher know if you will be unable to collect your child from the station.

There will not be any costs associated with this trip, however, as with everything, this would not be possible without your help. If you are able to come along and help us, we would be most grateful. There are limited spaces available and we are not able to accommodate any more adults than our allocated number. Indicate below if you wish to volunteer. Children are required to wear school uniform, sensible footwear and bring along a warm coat. A school packed lunch can be provided or you can send in your own. Again, please indicate this on the reply slip. Please return the reply slip to class or the School Office as soon as possible.
