Year 5 have started a 6 week lacross course which is one of the Pioneer Passport activities to 'learn a non curriculum sport'



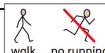

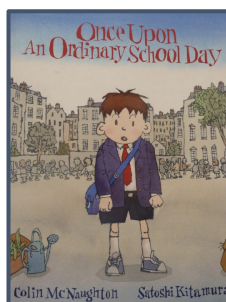
