Stickers, postcards, golden stickers, prize box, 50 dojo stickers, star of the week, head teacher award and dojos! The children love it!

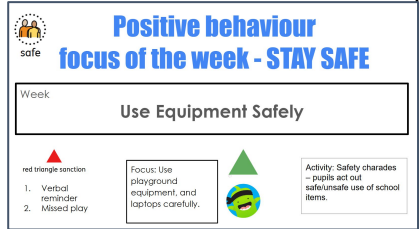

Our behaviour focus of the week is:

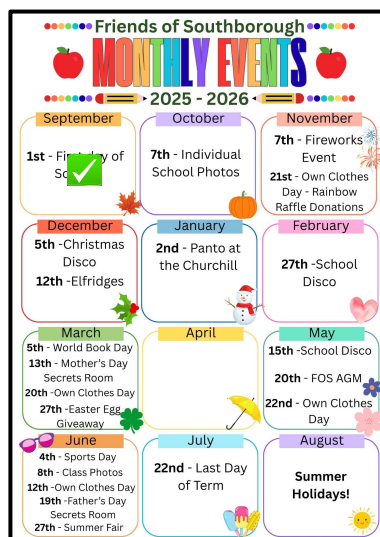


Staff changes
